

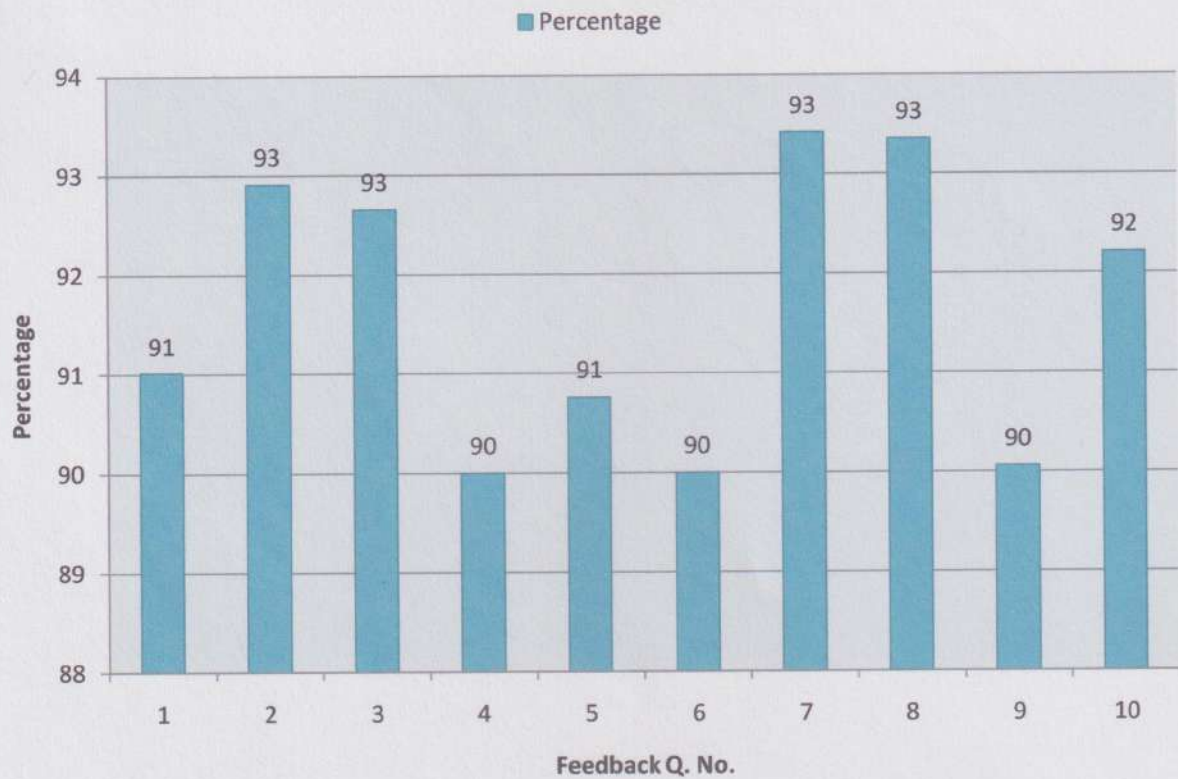




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**Analysis of Students Feedback about Teacher**  
**2022-2023**

The students are the important stakeholders in the higher education system. Their feedback plays important role in providing inputs for quality enhancement and development of educational institution. Students online feedback is obtained with the help of structured questionnaire from our third year undergraduate and second year post graduate students. Feedback obtained from students is analyzed that is given below:

1. Out of the total students 91% students opined that their teachers complete the entire syllabus in time.
2. Discussion of subject matter with the students is concerned 93% of students expressed that teachers discuss the subject matter with them in detail.
3. 93% students revealed that their teachers communicate with the students to provide the complete knowledge of the subjects.
4. 90% students expressed that their teachers provide necessary notes through social media like WhatsApp, Youtube, Wikipedia, etc. during classes.
5. 91% students commented that their teachers take regular classes with preparation.
6. 90% students opined that their teachers encourage students to participate and discuss the same subject matter on the platform.
7. 93% students opined that their teachers use modern educational tools for teaching.
