Analysis of Alumni Feedback: 2019-20



Sr. No.	Suggestion by Stakeholders : Particulars	Action Taken
1	Start professional courses	A short-term courses committee has been constituted to start various skilled based short-term course to enhance the employability of students.
2	Proper guidance for competitive exams (MPSC, UPSC, NET/SET)	Competitive Guidance Center is already providing guidance about the various competitive examinations. The collaboration with external agenc to start full fledge Competitive Guidance Center is being established to guide the students.
3	Conduct alumni meetings regularly	Alumni meet is organized once in year. Now it is decided that it will be organized twice a year.
4	Lack of physical facilities in classrooms	Adequate physical facilities with podiums, new benches, new black / green boards have been provided is the class rooms.
5	Updating library and availability of books	Library is now updated with the library software and as per the requirements the books are made available to the students.
6	Cleanliness and maintenance of washrooms	A sweeper has been appointed and he has been instructed for maintenance and cleanliness of washrooms regularly. It is also checked frequently.
7	Availability of ladies room and reading room	A provision of ladies room and reading rooms in made available to the students.
8	Improvement in canteen facility	Renovation of canteen is made and pure drinking facility is also provided to the students. The canteen vender is instructed about maintenance of cleanliness.
9	Start Science faculty courses	The management has decided to start B. Sc. programme from academic year 2020-21.
10	Provision of computer lab and ICT facility	A newly specious computer lab with state of art technology is developed and ICT facility is made available to the facility and students.
11	Use of technology in teaching	The faculty members are instructed to increase the use of ICT in their teaching methodology.
12	Add MCA courses	The suggestion has been put forth before the management and it under consideration.
